"Just Be Jersey" Child Safety Day: First Annual "Just Be Safe" Child ID and Protection Day will be held Sunday November 23, 2014 from 1-3 pm at the **Father Hembrow Center Cafeteria**. Families who participate will receive a free FBI-approved ID Kit and can receive assistance from volunteers including federal, state, county, and local law enforcement officials. The Kit contains a fingerprinting card and DNA collection swabs that, when completed, are to be maintained for safe-keeping by the parents. The event will also feature information and displays on vital child safety topics including child safety seats, fire education, drug abuse education, and internet safety.
